Burton, her father was as pastor and her mother a Life Member missionary in the African Methodist Episcopal Church. Rev. Thompkins attended St. James A.M.E. Church, Atlantic City (Pastor Rev. Dr. James Coaxum III) for over 35 years. She was called to the ordained ministry in 2009 and ordained in 2017. She matriculated at ITC in Atlanta and received her Master's Degree in Divinity from United Lutheran Seminary in Philadelphia in 2017. She is an Itinerant Elder in the African Methodist Episcopal Church.

She is the Coordinator for the Atlantic City Area Women in Ministry. Rev. Thompkins is one of the founding members of a National Women's Prayer Ministry, the Sista's of the Sanctuary (SOS). On the first Wednesday of the month she leads the 6:00 am (SOS) morning Meditation & Prayer Line. She currently serves as Pastor of a spirit-filled and faithful congregation at Bethel A.M.E. Church, Millville, New Jersey.

Rev. Thompkins has been a (R.N.) Registered Nurse for thirty-six years. She graduated from Howard University School of Nursing and received a Certificate in School Nursing from Rowan University. In 2021, she retired as a School Nurse. Currently, she works part-time as an Adjunct Nursing Instructor for a licensed Practical Nurse Program.

Thirty-two years ago, she married her wonderful, loving and supportive husband, Elisha Thompkins Jr., and together they have two adult children Ashley and Brian.
